

Do you know someone who could host a Ukrainian family already in Richmond?



Replacement hosts are urgently needed for a small number of displaced Ukrainians.

Since the start of the war in Ukraine, over 600 refugees have found sanctuary in our borough under the Government's Homes for Ukraine Scheme thanks to the goodwill and compassion of local hosts. They are accessing healthcare, schooling, language tuition, applicable benefits and seeking work. A range of support and welcoming activities has been put in place by the Council and voluntary groups across the borough.

Six months on, there are now **30 cases where refugees need to move on** due to illness or unforeseen changes in circumstances in their host's household. Under the Homes for Ukraine Scheme, hosts will receive **a monthly payment of £350** for the remainder of their guests' first year in the UK.
